The Calgary Downtown Association (CDA), Kensington, Uptown 17, 4th Street and Victoria Crossing BRZs are again partnering with the City of Calgary Animal and Bylaw Services to remove and reduce graffiti in the inner city.

As a team member, your job will be to:

- Record, report and remove graffiti in the designated BRZs
- Educate businesses in the BRZs about graffiti and its effects
- Determine supplies and other inventory items as needed... before they run out!
- Paint over large pieces of graffiti
- Help develop the program by identifying and implementing reporting methods, changes, etc...
- Other duties as assigned

Job Environment

1. Days will primarily be spent outdoors. Heat or wet weather may present uncomfortable conditions on occasion;
2. A great deal of walking is required as well as some minor lifting.
3. Employees will be required to carry fully supplied backpacks.
4. The employee is responsible for appropriate footwear. NO sandals or open toed footwear is permitted.
5. Partial uniforms will be provided.

- Maintain positive interaction with Downtown businesses, residents and visitors.
- You must always maintain a polite, helpful, pleasant and enthusiastic attitude when dealing with people.
- Report to supervisor(s) as designated, throughout the day.

- Must be able to work with minimal supervision.
- Enthusiastic, outgoing attitude.
- Physically fit and able to fulfill duties and responsibilities.
- Training and/or experience in maintenance, painting or other related fields is an asset.

Hours/Wages/ Benefits

Work week: 5 days per week, 40 hours per week. Weather may determine some hours.
Actual days and hours of work will vary depending on shifts assigned.
